JCSDA Ocean Breakout Session

- How would you rate the JCSDA activities in your subject areas?
 - Important activities; Oceans WG developing and important for partner communications and sharing of experiences
 - Need to increase activities that are important to NWP (Ocean is important lower BC heard importance of SST and SSS from atmospheric assimilation, CRTM)
 - Most important area is improving use of altimeter data partitioning of information between T(z) and S(z)
 - Both Bob Miller and Alexey Kaplan contributing in this area
 - Partners need to share information
 - Relevant to both operational oceanography and climate ocean applications
- What should be the top priority if additional funding were to become available? Internal, external?
 - Internal: Share Navy's sea-ice assimilation into other partner systems
 - Internal/External: preparation for sea surface salinity (even use of climatologies)
 - Use of ocean color (important for near-surface temperatures)
- Are there data types or subject areas where the JCSDA is missing the boat?
 - Coordinate efforts to develop more sophisticated and physically-based assimilation methods for mean and spectral satellite observations of surface wind waves, especially from SAR wave data.
